Follow the steps below for class (Block 4, 6, and 8):

After you read the persuasive essay in class and discuss, have the students work independently on their work.

2. Students should begin writing their persuasive essay first draft in their notebooks. *Remind students that their first draft should be **in pencil** and that they should **skip 2 lines** (this will allow for revisions and editing later).*
