

POSTER BOOK PROJECT

DUE: FEBRUARY 3RD

For this project, you will create a poster about your book. Your goal is to encourage others to read your book, so choose a book that you actually enjoyed and would recommend to others.

Your poster must include the following:

- Title and author
- Summary of the book based on what you have read. Include enough details to convince me you have read the required pages.
- Review of the book – a short paragraph (at least five sentences) giving your opinion of the book so far. You must include examples or quotes to back up your generalizations. I
- Favorite passage - select your favorite part of the book, type it, and paste it to your poster. Your passage must be at least 50 words.
- Illustrations – can be a collage, computer-generated, or drawings that relate to your book.
- Character poem – see below.

Your poster will be graded creativity and neatness. After reading your poster, I should get a feel for your book and be encouraged to read it. You must also present your poster to the class and tell us about your book. Be prepared to answer questions about your book.

CHARACTER POEM

To introduce others to a character in your book, individually you will create and type a six-line character poem. This poem should give us a glimpse into the physical appearance and personality of your character. Be sure to include three examples of figurative language. Use the following format to write your poem:

Line 1: Name of the character.

Line 2: At least three adjectives that describe the character's appearance.

Line 3: Something or someone you associate with this character.

Line 4: Three action words associated with this character (use –ing ending).

Line 5: When or where these actions are performed.

Line 6: Your opinion or reaction to this character.

Example:

Tomas Torres
Fit, strong, and curious
Like a boy on a journey
Fishing, climbing, and swimming
In a town that listens to the ocean sing
Very smart and caring to those around him.
